#### Profile of the Class of 2019

The class of 2019 numbered 61 in September of 2018. 57 students received their diplomas at the graduation ceremony held on June 27, 2019. We had one student who received her diploma in January 2019. Of the three who did not complete requirements for the June graduation date, one was planning to pursue a high school equivalency, one is planning to attend a summer program to graduate in August and the last is unsure of his plans.

- 1. Fourteen (24%) graduated with sequences acquired in our business and technology programs or career and technical education.
- 2. Forty Nine (84%) will attend two or four year colleges; six students (10%) will enter the work-force; one (2%) will attend a trade school; one (2%) will go into the military; and one (2%) is undecided.
