

Profile of the Class of 2020

The class of 2020 numbered 55 in September of 2019. 51 students received their diplomas at the graduation ceremonies held on July 12, 2020. Of the four who did not complete requirements for the July graduation date, two are working in our summer program to graduate in August; the two other students are unsure of their plans.

1. Twenty One (41%) graduated with sequences acquired in our business and technology programs or career and technical education.
2. Forty Five (88%) will attend two or four year colleges; four students (8%) will enter the work-force; and two (4%) will go into the military;
